



## **WICKED RUNNING CLUB SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION 2012**

The Wicked Running Club will be awarding four scholarships to area high school or collegiate runners in the Spring of 2012. Funding for the scholarships is made possible from the revenue generated by the Wicked Frosty Four road race put on by the Wicked Running club each New Year's Day. Consideration will be given to runners of all abilities who meet the eligibility requirements.

Eligibility requirements to receive a scholarship from the Wicked Running Club are:

- Essex County, Massachusetts resident at time of application;
- Participation in a cross country or track distance running (>800 meters) program as a high school senior;
- Acceptance to a college or current enrollment in a college.

Scholarships will be awarded based on a combination of academic achievement, contributions to their team, volunteer/community work and quality of application and essay. Preference will be given to residents of Wicked Running Club member towns.

Each applicant shall submit the following information to the selection committee, incomplete applications cannot be considered for scholarship awards:

1. Completed scholarship application;
2. Copy of current high school transcript including standardized test score OR (if currently in college) copy of most recent college transcript;
3. A typed essay - 500 words or less;
4. Two letters of recommendation- one of which will be from the student's current track or cross country coach the other from a teacher/professor; and
5. A letter of acceptance (if in high school) and tuition costs from the college or school you will be / are attending (tuition costs can be printed from the institution's website if not included in the acceptance package).
